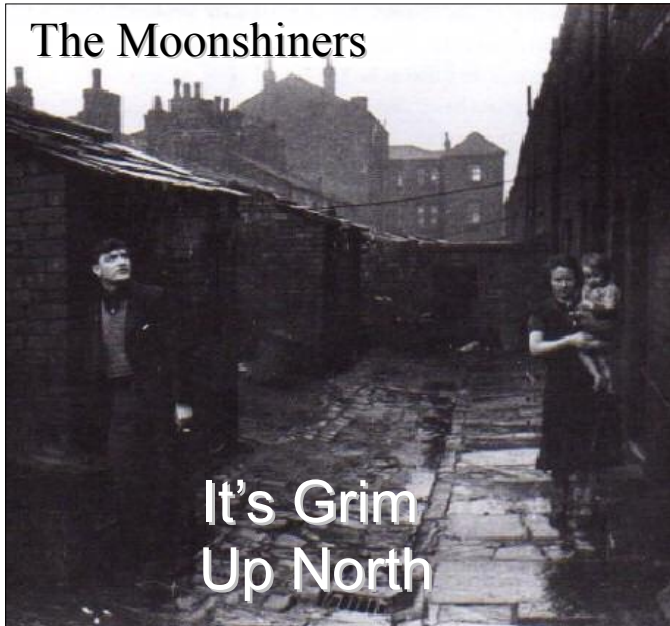


It's Grim Up North
